RULES AND REGULATIONS

TEAMS: Contestants must enter as two man teams. Contestants must check in at the rules meeting, Friday, April 29, 2011 at 7:00 p.m. CST.

TACKLE AND EQUIPMENT: Artificial and live lures may be used. Each contestant may use two rods. Only two fishermen are allowed per boat. Boating entrants only.

FISHING AREA: Big Bend Dam to the mouth of the White River. All boats must leave from and return to Cedar Shore boat ramp in Chamberlain. The east lane of the boat ramp shall remain open at all times for non-tournament boats only. Tournament participants shall park their vehicles at the marina.

FISHING HOURS: The tournament will be held from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m., Saturday, April 30, 2011. Hours subject to revision by the agreement of the contestants at the rules meeting on April 29, 2011.

SCORING: Prizes will be based on most weight, pounds and ounces, during the tournament. Each boat will be permitted to catch 7 total fish, 7 walleyes will be weighed.

ENTRY FEES: A \$100.00 check or money order (per team) must accompany each entry form postmarked prior to midnight, April 1, 2011. Following that date, entry fee will be \$115.00 per team. No entry fees will be returned if cancellation arrives after April 11, 2011. PIM reserves the right to refuse entries received after April 15, 2011. In the event this option is elected, application and fee will be returned.

CALCUTTA: Calcutta teams are sold by blocks, but paid by team weight. Calcutta pay off will be 1st place team — 35%; 2nd place team — 25%; 3rd place team — 15%; 4th place team — 10% and 5th place team — 5%.
